GLERA

Glera is a famous white grape variety, symbolic of wine production in the Veneto region. It dates perhaps as far back as the Roman times and was cultivated mainly in the Veneto region, as well as in Friuli-Venezia Giulia, especially in the area around Treviso.

The area where this type of grape is, without doubt, most successful is the hilly Altamarca land around Treviso.

This variety prefers hilly terrain that is not too dry, in areas protected from any spring frosts.

It grows best with upwards-training/trellising systems or similar. In particular, it likes the double-arched cane or Guyot training systems, with long winter pruning.

Owing to the vigour of the vegetation, it also requires summer pruning.

The wine produced is straw-yellow in colour; it is fresh-tasting, fruity and flowery, as well as being dense, golden yellow, and slightly punctuated.
