



VERDISO

Verdiso is an ancient grape variety, native to the Altamarca area around Treviso, that grows in warmer, well-ventilated areas. In the years where the grapes are able to ripen well, it is a vigorous variety that has a late ripening period. It produces grapes abundantly and regularly.

The wine produced is dry and lively, recalling tart apple with a slightly bitter finish. Its alcohol content is average, and its colour pale straw-yellow with greenish tinges. It has a subtle, delicate and elegant aroma that is slightly fruity. It has slim body, a fresh, savoury taste and a pleasant presence of acidity. Overall, it is well orchestrated and pervades well in the palate. It is often accompanied by a slight prickle, making it pleasantly drinkable.
